

Maryland COVID-19 Travel Testing and/or Quarantine Requirements

Updated February 11, 2021

Pursuant to Executive Order 20-12-17-01 and Health Article §§18-601,18-902, all Marylanders who travel outside of Maryland and individuals who travel to Maryland shall: Immediately get a COVID-19 test upon arrival in Maryland or within 72 hours before travel to Maryland. This order makes no distinction between vaccinated or non-vaccinated individuals at this time.

Who is Required to Be Tested

- ❖ Travelers Where Maryland is Your Final Destination
 - Immediately get a COVID-19 test upon arrival in Maryland or within 72 hours before travel to Maryland.
 - Symptomatic travelers shall self-isolate upon arrival in Maryland. They are strongly encouraged not to travel to Maryland if they are showing signs of illness.
 - Asymptomatic shall self-quarantine while awaiting COVID- 19 testing results.

Who is not Required to Be Tested For COVID-19?

- ❖ Travelers passing through the state where Maryland is not their final destination
- ❖ Marylanders who travel to the District of Columbia, Pennsylvania, Virginia, Delaware, and West Virginia
- ❖ Employees that regularly commute to Maryland for work.
- ❖ Asymptomatic individuals who have tested positive for COVID-19 in the previous 90 days and completed isolation in accordance with CDC guidance Printed or electronic documentation is required.
