

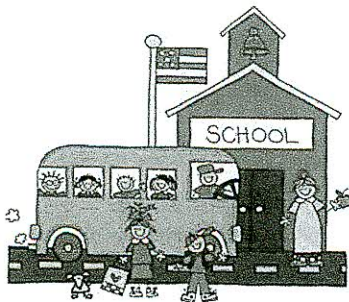
Friendsville Elementary and the Judy Center A Title 1 School

Dear Parents,

Welcome to PreK! We are so excited to have your child in our class this year. Here are some important things we want you to know.

The first week of school will be a staggered start for PreK students. Your child will only come to school 3 days the first week. This helps each child learn the classroom schedule and routines in a smaller group. It also helps with separation anxiety on the first day. You will receive your child's schedule in August. Your child may **only** come on the teacher selected days during the first week. We will start following a normal schedule the second week of school.

- Your child needs the following supplies.
 1. Folding Rest Mat, small blanket, and pillow (for rest- please label with your child's name)
 2. Bookbag (regular size)
 3. Clorox Wipes (three containers)
 4. Tissues (one box)
 5. Paper Towels (three rolls)
 6. Sanitizer (1 bottle)
 7. Extra change of clothes (pants, shirt, underwear labeled with your child's name in a labeled ziploc bag)
 8. Crayons (24 count)
 9. Watercolor Paint Set (16 Color)
 10. Glue Sticks (6)
